SECTION -1

1.1 INTRODUCTION

- **1.1.1** The Guwahati Smart City Limited (GSCL) invites proposals from interested firms /agencies/companies for 20 Mbps Leased Line (OFC) based Internet Connectivity (1:1) uncompressed & unshared with last mile on fibre at Guwahati Smart City Limited, 4th Floor Aditya Tower, Opp. Down Town Hospital, Dispur, Guwahati Assam for a period of (1) one year from the date of in installation and commissioning.
- **1.1.2** The GSCL intends to select the firms /agencies / companies for this tender through a transparent competitive bidding process in accordance with the procedure set out herein.

1.2 OBTAINING THE TENDER DOCUMENT

The Tender document can be downloaded from the GSCL website (www.gscdal.in) from the dates mentioned in the previous pages. A demand draft for an amount of Rs. 1,000 (Rupees One thousand only) to be drawn on any Nationalized Bank in India in favour of Managing Director, Guwahati Smart City Limited and payable at Guwahati needs to be submitted along with the tender towards the cost of tender fee.

1.3 VALIDITY OF PROPOSAL

The Proposal shall be valid for a period of 180 days from the Proposal Due Date. GSCL reserves the right to reject any bid which does not meet the bid validity duration.

1.4 BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SELECTION PROCESS

The GSCL has adopted a Single Stage — Two Rounds selection process (collectively "Selection Process") in evaluating the Proposals comprising technical (pre-qualification) and financial bids to be submitted in two separate sealed envelopes. The bidders who qualify the Technical Bid stage will automatically qualify for the Financial Round. Based on this, a list of short-listed Bidders shall be prepared and the financial bid of those qualified bidders shall be evaluated.

1.6 CLARIFICATIONS

- **1.6.1** Any Bidder requiring any clarification may notify the GSCL in writing. GSCL will respond to any request for clarification as per the calendar of the event prior to the deadline for submission of Bids.
- **1.6.2** To facilitate evaluation of Proposal, GSCL may, at its sole discretion, seek clarifications in writing from any Bidder regarding its Proposal. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Bid Document, GSCL reserves the right not to take into consideration any such clarifications sought by it for evaluation of the Proposal and also reserves the right not to respond to any correspondence received from the Bidder after the Proposal Due Date.

1.7 BIDDER RESPONSIBILITIES

- **1.7.1** Each Bidder is expected to examine carefully the contents of all the documents provided and consisting of this Bid Document. Failure to comply with the requirements of this Bid document will be at the Bidders own risk.
- **1.7.2** It would be deemed that prior to the submission of the tender, the Bidder has to:
 - **1.7.2.1** Made a complete and careful examination of requirements and other information set forth in this Bid document:
 - 1.7.2.2 Received all such relevant information as it has requested from GSCL; and
 - **1.7.2.3** Made a complete and careful examination of the various aspects of the Project. GSCL shall not be liable for any inadvertent mistake or error or neglect by the Bidder in respect of the above.
- **1.7.3** Each Bidder shall submit only 1 (one) bid in response to this Tender. Submission of more than 1 (one) bid by any Bidder shall be sufficient ground for disqualification of the Bidder.
- 1.7.4 No interpretation, revision, or other communication from GSCL regarding this solicitation is valid unless in writing and signed by the competent authority from GSCL. GSCL reserves the right to reject any Bid which is not sealed and marked as instructed above and GSCL will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the Bid which is not sealed and marked as instructed above. GSCL reserves the right not to follow up this Tender and terminate the entire selection process without any obligation or liability to any of the Bidders, of any kind whatsoever.
- 1.7.5 The Bidder shall be responsible for all costs associated with the preparation of its Proposal and its participation in the Bidding Process. GSCL will not be responsible in any way liable for such costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Bidding Process.

1.8 LATE PROPOSALS

Any Proposal received after the time and date of the Proposal Due Date shall not be accepted and summarily rejected.

1.9 MODIFICATIONS / SUBSTITUTION / WITHDRAWAL OF PROPOSALS

A Bidder submitting its Bid prior to the Proposal Due Date may modify, substitute,

Or withdraw its Bid after submission, provided that written notice of the modification, substitution, or withdrawal is received by GSCL before the Proposal Due Date. It is hereby clarified that no Proposal shall be modified, substituted or withdrawn by the Bidder after the Proposal Due Date.

1.10 NON-DISCRIMINATORY AND TRANSPARENT BIDDING PROCEEDINGS

GSCL shall ensure that the rules for the bidding proceedings for the Project are applied in a non-discriminatory, transparent and objective manner. GSCL shall not provide information to any Bidder with regard to the Project or the bidding proceedings, which may have the effect of restricting competition.

1.11 CONFIDENTIALITY

Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation, and recommendation for the Bidders shall not be disclosed to any person not officially concerned with the process. GSCL will treat all information submitted as part of Proposal in confidence and would require all those who have access to such material to treat the same in confidence. GSCL will not divulge any such information unless it is ordered to do so by any authority that has the power under law to require its disclosure which is required for the purposes of evaluation of the Proposals submitted by the Bidders.

1.12 NOTIFICATION

The Selected Bidder would be declared and notified in writing by GSCL. Letter of Intent (LOI) to the Selected Bidder shall be issued.

1.13 GSCL RIGHT TO ACCEPT OR REJECT PROPOSAL

- **1.13.1** GSCL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all of the bids without assigning any reason and to take any measure as it may deem fit, including annulment of the Bidding Process, at any time prior to Issue of LOI, without liability or any obligation for such acceptance, rejection or annulment.
- **1.13.2** GSCL reserves the right to invite fresh bids by issuing a fresh notice at any stage without liability or any obligation for such invitation and without assigning any reason.
- **1.13.3** GSCL reserves the right to reject any Bid if:
 - **1.13.3.1** The Bidder does not respond promptly and thoroughly to requests for supplementary information required for the evaluation of the bid; or
 - **1.13.3.2** The Bid is not accompanied by documents and annexure required to be submitted in accordance with this Bid document; or
 - 1.13.3.3 Failure to comply with the requirements of the Bid document; or
 - 1.13.3.4 Any Bid that is received after the Proposal Due Date; or
 - 1.13.3.5 Any bid that is not accompanied by the Tender Fee and Earnest Money.
- **1.13.4** The above would lead to disqualification of the Bidder. If the Bidder is a consortium, then the entire consortium would be disqualified/rejected.
- 1.13.5 In case, the Selected Bidder fails to execute the Agreement within Forty Five (45) days of issuance of LOI, GSCL reserves the right to invite the second eligible Bidder (L2) for discussions/negotiations or may also decide to annul the Bidding Process or may invite fresh bids for the work. In case the Selected Bidder fails to execute the Agreement within specified timelines or fails to submit the Bank Guarantee in terms of the Bid

document, the entire EMD submitted by the Selected Bidder shall be forfeited by the GSCL. However, GSCL on receiving request from the Selected Bidder may at its absolute discretion, permit extension of the aforesaid period of 45 (forty five) days for execution of the respective agreement(s).

- **1.13.6** The EMD of unsuccessful Bidders will be returned after the declaration of the selected bidder.
- **1.13.7** Notwithstanding anything contained in the Bid document, if there is only one Bidder complying with the conditions of the Technical Bid evaluation and is declared "Qualified" after completion of such evaluation, GSCL may at its own discretion relax the norms of evaluation and pre-qualify the next best bidders.

- **1.14.1** All Bids must be submitted, duly signed by the Bidder
- **1.14.2** Bidders may note that GSCL will not entertain any deviations to this Bid document at the time of submission of the Bid or thereafter. The Bid to be submitted by the Bidders shall

be unconditional and the Bidders would be deemed to have accepted the terms and conditions of the Bid Document with all its contents and Addendums issued thereafter. Any conditional Bid shall be regarded as non-responsive and would be liable for rejection.

1.15 PROPOSAL DUE DATE AND TIME

1.15.1 The proposals in the prescribed form should be submitted to MD, GSCL at GMDA ,Statfed Building , Bhangargh, Guwahati on or before the scheduled date and time of proposal due date as stated in the schedule of bidding process. Bids submitted by fax transmission /e-mail shall not be accepted.

1.16 BIDDING SYSTEM (SINGLE STAGE – TWO ROUND BID SYSTEM)

- 1.16.1 For the selection of bidder to execute work for Supply, Installation, Commissioning and Maintenance of Leased Line based Internet Connectivity; GSCL has adopted a Single Stage Two Round System. The first Round comprises of the Technical Bid and second Round is the Financial Bid. The Bidders would be required to furnish the information specified in the Bid document.
- 1.16.2 All Bidders are required to submit duly filled Bid documents (Technical and Financial Bid) in accordance with the guidelines set forth in this Document. The evaluation of prequalification and technical bid shall be carried out in accordance with the terms and conditions provided in the Bid document.
- **1.16.3** The Evaluation of the Financial Bid (Envelope 2) would be carried out on the basis of the evaluation of the pre-qualification criteria as per the criteria mentioned in the Bid document. The Financial Bid (Envelope 2) of only those Bidders would be opened who "Qualify" the Pre-qualification round.

1.17 PREPARATION & SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- **1.17.1** The Bidder would provide all the information as per the Bid document. GSCL reserves the right to evaluate only those bids that are received in the required format complete in all respects and in line with the instructions contained herein.
- **1.17.2** The language of the bid and related documents and correspondence shall be English.
- **1.17.3** The currency for the purpose of the Bid shall be Indian Rupees.
- **1.17.4** The Proposal should be submitted in 2 (Two) separate envelopes and put together in 1 (one) single outer envelope in the following manner:
 - **1.17.4.1** The pages and volumes of each part of the Bid shall be clearly numbered and stamped and the contents duly indexed. The Bid should not include any loose papers other than Tender Fee and EMD.
 - **1.17.4.2** The typed or printed Proposal shall be signed and each page of the Proposal shall be initialled by a person or persons duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Bidder.
 - 1.17.4.3 The bid shall contain no alterations or additions, except those to comply with instructions issued by GSCL or as necessary to correct errors made by the Bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialled by the person or persons signing the bid.

Envelope 2: Financial Bid

Envelope 2 should contain only the duly filled in Financial Bid of the Bidders. The financial bid should not be conditional.

1.18.5 SEALING AND MARKING OF PROPOSAL

- **1.18.5.1** The Bidder shall seal each of the envelopes duly marking each envelope as "TECHNICAL BID" and "FINANCIAL BID" as the case may be.
- **1.18.5.2** The Bidder shall put the 2 (two) separate envelopes containing the Technical Bid and Financial Bid respectively in a single outer envelope and seal the outer envelope.
- **1.18.5.3** The outer envelopes shall clearly bear the following identification.

"Tender for 20 Mbps Internet Leased Line (OFC) Connectivity (1:1) uncompressed & unshared with last mile on fibre at Guwahati Smart City Limited, 4th Floor Aditya Tower, Opp. Down Town Hospital, Dispur, Guwahati -Assam"

Each of the envelopes shall indicate the complete name, address, telephone number and fax number/E-mail of the Bidder.

1.19 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)

1.19.1 The bid should be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit. The EMD shall be kept valid throughout the period of 45 (forty five) days beyond the Proposal Validity Period including any extensions thereto and would be required to be extended further if so

required by GSCL. Any extension of the validity of the EMD as requested by GSCL shall be provided to GSCL, a minimum of 7 (seven calendar) days prior to the expiry of the validity of the EMD, being extended. When an extension of the Bid Validity Period is requested, Bidders shall not be permitted to change the terms and conditions of their Bids. GSCL reserves the right to reject the bid submitted by any Bidder who fails to extend the validity of the EMD in line with the provisions of this clause.

- 1.19.2 The EMD shall be in the form of a Demand Draft /Bank Guarantee issued by a Nationalized Bank in favour of the Managing Director ,Guwahati Smart City Limited payable at Guwahati. GSCL shall not be liable to pay any interest on the EMD so made and the same shall be interest free. It shall be the responsibility of the Bidder to extend the validity of the EMD instruments as and when required. Non-renewal of the same shall result into cancellation of bid of the bidder.
- 1.19.3 The EMD of unsuccessful Bidders will be returned by GSCL, without any interest, as promptly as possible upon acceptance of LoI by the Selected Bidder or when the Bidding Process is annulled by the GSCL. GSCL shall reject the bid which does not include the EMD as a part of Technical Bid. GSCL shall reject the bid, if the bid submitted by the Bidder is declared non-responsive/ non-qualified/conditional by GSCL; or if the bid is not as per the Format(s) provided in the Bid document.
- **1.19.4** The entire EMD shall be forfeited in the following cases:
 - a) If the Bidder withdraws its bid;
 - b) If the Bidder withdraws its Proposal during the interval between the Proposal Due Date and expiration of the validity period of the bid;
 - c) If the Selected Bidder fails to submit the Bank Guarantee(s) in favour of GSCL or fails to sign the Agreement within the stipulated time.
 - d) If the Selected Bidder fails to meet any other pre-requisite for signing of Agreement as per the terms of this Tender.

1.20 BID OPENING DATE

- **1.20.1** GSCL would open the Envelope 1 (Technical Bid) at the time and date indicated in the Schedule of important events or its subsequent extension through Addendum in the presence of Bidders" representatives, who choose to attend. Bidders representatives attending the Proposal Opening Process shall mark their presence with the GSCL.
- **1.20.2** Proposals for which an acceptable notice of withdrawal has been submitted shall not be opened.

1.21 Opening of Bids

- a. Step 1: Pre-qualification cum technical bid will be opened by the Bid Committee at Guwahati Smart City Limited, Statfed Building, Bhangaghar, Guwahati on its date & time specified in the Tender document.
- b. Step 2: Financial bid will be opened by the Evaluation Committee of those bidders who have qualified in the Pre- qualification cum technical bid as specified in the Tender document.
- c. In the event of the date specified for bid receipt and opening being declared as a holiday, the bids will be received/opened the following working day at the appointed times.

1.21.2 Pre-Qualification cum Technical Bid: Evaluation

A duly constituted Tender Committee shall shortlist the Technical Bids on the basis of Technical Parameters The names of short listed bidders will be communicated to the respective bidders only whose Technical bids are found suitable for opening the financial bids. The Financial bids will be evaluated by a duly constituted Tender Committee.

1.21.3 Financial BID Evaluation Process

Financial Bid will be opened only for technically qualified bidders. L1 / lowest bidder will be decided on total quoted price inclusive of installation charges and all taxes and duties, and the bidder who will quote total minimum price will be declared as lowest (L1) bidder.

1.22 ISSUE OF LETTER OF INTENT (LOI) & ITS ACCEPTANCE

- **1.22.1** The GSCL shall within 7 days of completing the entire evaluation process declare the Selected Bidder by issuing the Letter of Intent to the Selected Bidder and within 7 days from the date of issue of the LOI the Selected Bidder shall submit his acceptance of the same.
- **1.22.2** The Selected Bidder shall also be required to execute the Agreement within 15 (fifteen) days from date of acceptance of LOI.
- **1.22.3** The successful bidder is expected to immediately take up the work and complete it within the period of 30 days.

1.23 SCOPE OF WORK

- **1.23.1** The bidder shall deploy, install, commission 20 Mbps Internet Leased Line (OFC) Connectivity (1:1 uncompressed and unshared) at GSCL, 4th Floor, Aditya Tower, Opp. Down Town Hospital, Dispur, Guwahati, Assam for a period of (1) one year including Hardware and Software.
- **1.23.2** The Bidder shall maintain and rectify problem/downtime of 20 Mbps Leased Line at GSCL office upto 12 months from go-live date.
- **1.23.3** The installation to be completed within one (1) Month from the date of signing of contract as directed by GSCL.

1.24 Contract Period

The initial contract between Guwahati Smart City Limited and bidder shall be valid for a period of (1) one year from the date of issuance of Acceptance Test (AT) certificate.

1.25 Warranty of Services

- **1.25.1** The bidder will be responsible for the comprehensive maintenance during the warranty period of one year.
- **1.25.2** The bidder shall provide 98.5% (Minimum) uptime at GSCL office on $24 \times 7 \times 365$ basis. If the downtime is beyond committed uptime, on quarterly basis deduction shall be made as per below penalty clause 3.25.3.

1.25.3 The services shall be provided as per uptime parameters mentioned below:

1.26 Payments

- **1.26.1** The Internet lease line charges will be paid on Quarterly Guaranteed Revenue (QGR) on receipt of invoice in triplet copy.
- **1.26.2** Installation and Commissioning Schedule and Penalty: Bidder should install these items at GSCL Office, 4th Floor, Aditya Tower, opposite Down Town Hospital, Dispur, Guwahati, without any additional charge. Commissioning and Testing should be completed in 30 days from the scheduled date of LOI. The delay in commissioning will carry a penalty of 0.2% (point two percent) for a period of 15 days and 0.4% (point four percent) per day for next 15 days subject to maximum 30 days in total. Thereafter, GSCL holds the option to get the procured item through alternate sources at the risk and cost of the defaulting bidder.
- **1.26.3** The Acceptance Testing certificate is mandatory for submission of bill. The bidder may submit bill (inclusive of all taxes) of project. The amount of bill (inclusive of all taxes) shall not be more than the quoted price/L1 price in the Financial Bid. The Bidder will request payment to GSCL as per payment terms mentioned in the Tender document.

- **1.26.4** Payments shall be made subject to deductions of any amount for which vendor is liable and deduction under late supply, Installation and Commissioning clause, and SLA monitoring.
- **1.26.5** Further, all payments shall be made subject to deduction of TDS (Tax deduction at Source) as per the Income-Tax Act, 1961 and any other taxes.

1.27 Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) for Operations

The Selected bidder (L1 bidder) for this project will submit a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) to The Managing Director, M/s Guwahati Smart City Limited, Statfed Building, Bhangagarh, Guwahati for an amount equal to 10% of Project Value within 15 days of the issuance of Letter of intent (LOI). The PBG will be valid for a period of 1 Year.

The PBG will be denominated in Indian Rupees and will be in the form of a Bank Guarantee (BG) issued by a Nationalized Bank or scheduled bank located in India with at least one branch office at Guwahati, Assam.

In case, Bidder unable to perform his duties as per agreement signed between M/s GSCL and successful bidder, GSCL may forfeit the PBG for whole or any part of required service to complete its obligations under the Agreement. The PBG will be returned to the bidder within 30 days of the successful discharge of all contractual obligations at the end of the period of the project.

1.28 Trouble Shooting

Bidder shall respond with a solution within one working hour of reporting of a problem and restore satisfactory operation within four working hours.

1.29 Performance Reports
